

READ ALOUD CHRISTMAS STORY

The Greatest Gift Ever Given

This script can be used for your Christmas program at church, for caroling at a nursing home, at your company Christmas party, or with family during Christmas.*

CAST: Narrator, Angel #1, Mary, Angel #2, Shepherds, Wise Men, Herod, Chief Priests & Scribes, & Song Leader **APPROXIMATE LENGTH:** 30-35 minutes

Narrator: Follow along as we recall the story of Jesus of Nazareth — "The Greatest Gift Ever Given."

Christ's Birth Announced to Mary (Luke 1:26-38)

²⁶ Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, ²⁷ to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name *was* Mary. ²⁸ And having come in, the angel said to her,

Angel #1: "Rejoice, highly favored *one*, the Lord *is* with you; blessed *are* you among women!"

Narrator: ²⁹ But when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and considered what manner of greeting this was. ³⁰ Then the angel said to her,

Angel #1: "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. ³¹ And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name Jesus. ³² He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. ³³ And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."

Narrator: ³⁴Then Mary said to the angel,

Mary: "How can this be, since I do not know a man?"

Narrator: 35 And the angel answered and said to her,

Angel #1: "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God. ³⁶ Now indeed, Elizabeth your relative has also conceived a son in her old age; and this is now the sixth month for her who was called barren. ³⁷ For with God nothing will be impossible."

Narrator: 38 Then Mary said,

Mary: "Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word."

Narrator: And the angel departed from her.

Song Leader: "O Come All Ye Faithful" (Verses 1, 3, 4 suggested — or "It Came Upon A Midnight Clear", Page 22 all 4 verses suggested)

The Angel Appears to Joseph (Matthew 1:20-23) CHRISTMAS STORY, CONTINUED

Narrator: ²⁰ But while he (Joseph) thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying,

Angel #1: "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. ²¹ And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."

Narrator: ²²So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying:

Angel #2: ²³ "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us."

Song Leader: "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel" (verses 1 & 2 suggested)

Narrator: ¹ And it came to pass in those days *that* a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered. ² This census first took place while Quirinius was governing Syria. ³ So all went to be registered, everyone to his own city.

⁴ Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, ⁵ to be registered with Mary, his betrothed wife, who was with child. ⁶ So it was, that while they were there, the days were complete for her to be delivered. ⁷ And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

Song Leader: "O Little Town of Bethlehem" (Verses 1, 2, 4 suggested)

CHRISTMAS STORY, CONTINUED

Narrator: ⁸ Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. ⁹ And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid. ¹⁰ Then the angel said to them,

Angel #2: "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. ¹¹ For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. ¹² And this *will be* the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger."

Narrator: ¹³ And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying:

Angel #2: 14 "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!"

Narrator: ¹⁵ So it was, when the angels had gone away from them into heaven, that the shepherds said to one another.

Shepherds: "Let us go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has come to pass, which the Lord has made known to us."

Narrator: ¹⁶ And they came with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the Babe lying in a manger. ¹⁷ Now when they had seen *Him*, they made widely known the saying which was told them concerning this Child. ¹⁸ And all those who heard *it* marveled at those things which were told them by the shepherds. ¹⁹ But Mary kept all these things and pondered *them* in her heart. ²⁰ Then the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told them.

Wise Men from the East (Matthew 2:1-11)

CHRISTMAS STORY, CONTINUED

Narrator: ¹Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, ²saying,

Wise Men: "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him."

Narrator: ³ When Herod the king heard *this*, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. ⁴ And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. ⁵ So they said to him,

Chief Priests & Scribes: "In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it is written by the prophet: ⁶ 'But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, Are not the least among the rulers of Judah: For out of you shall come a Ruler Who will shepherd My people Israel.'"

Narrator: ⁷Then Herod, when he had secretly called the wise men, determined from them what time the star appeared. ⁸And he sent them to Bethlehem and said,

Herod: "Go and search carefully for the young Child, and when you have found *Him*, bring back word to me, that I may come and worship Him also."

Narrator: ⁹When they heard the king, they departed; and behold, the star which they had seen in the East went before them, till it came and stood over where the young Child was. ¹⁰When they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceedingly great joy. ¹¹ And when they had come into the house, they saw the young Child with Mary His mother, and fell down and worshiped Him. And when they had opened their treasures, they presented gifts to him: gold, frankincense and myrrh.

Song Leader: "We Three Kings of Orient Are" (Verses 1, 2 & 5 suggested)

Wise Men Warned (Matthew 2:12)

CHRISTMAS STORY, CONTINUED

Narrator: 12 Then, being divinely warned in a dream that they should not return to Herod, they (the wise men) departed for their own country another way.

Isaiah's Prophecy of Christ (Isaiah 9:6) & Fulfillment (John 3:16)

Narrator: And so, these things came to pass that had been spoken of by the prophet Isaiah over 700 years before the birth of Jesus Christ, our Saviour:

⁶For unto us a Child is born, **unto us a Son is aiven**: And the government will be upon His shoulder.

Shepherds: And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Song Leader: Ending Song: "Joy to The World" (All 4 Verses suggested)

Narrator: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16) Jesus Christ is "The Greatest Gift Ever Given." How do you receive this gift of Jesus? "That if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

Will you receive this gift today?

If desired, finish with a prayer, then sing the chorus of "We Wish You a Merry Christmas".

Caroling Instructions

Every caroling group starts with a leader who is willing to invite family, friends, neighbors, church members, colleagues, youth groups, employers or senior groups to join them.

Pick up free copies of the Christmas Blue Pages (or download) for each member of the group.

Set a time to meet, and decide where you want to go and sing

Plan on 60 to 120 minutes of caroling

Don't make this complex -- just get together and sing!

Where to Carol

You get to choose the path that your caroling group will follow. Great places to caroling include:

Your neighborhood or neighborhood around your church

The community around your workplace

The parking lots of apartment complexes

With advanced permission, consider caroling:

To the residents of a nursing home or senior living center

To the patrons of a restaurant

At the entrance of a church service or event

At a Nativity display or a lot where Christmas trees are sold

Choose a well lit area and consider the safety needs of your group.

In a two hour time period, you can ring the doorbells of 10-20 homes and sing 5-10 times.

How to Carol

The following recommendations will help you to have a successful and safe caroling experience:

Form a group of 7-20 people

Start your effort with a prayer for the people to whom you'll be singing

Stay together as you walk on the sidewalks through a neighborhood

Stand 10-20 feet away from the front door of the residence. It's OK to stand in the grass next to the sidewalk. Don't crowd onto the front porch.

Identify one person to ring the doorbell after the caroling group is in place.

When the door is opened, sing one to two songs. When finished, say "Merry

Christmas". As you are leaving, sing "We Wish You A Merry Christmas."

Offer a copy of the Christmas Blue Pages to the people to whom you are caroling.

Bring Flashlights!

Do NOT Do This When Caroling
